Monday, December 29th

7:30 AM -Meet at Mack's (the old Shoney's) for breakfast

11:00 AM -Arrive at Woodland Valley and warm up

12:00 PM -First tee time

5:00 PM -All head to eat supper, go over scores, and start giving last place a hard time!

7:00 PM - Arrive at hotel, hangout, watch football, Krispy Kreme, etc.

1:30 -Those who wish can play nine more holes

Tournament Rules:

*It is very important for scoring purposes that you follow the rules of play.

*Follow USGA rules for all rounds except for the following circumstances:

- a) You may clean your ball at any time, just mark it and replace it
- b) You can move your ball a club length anywhere in the rough or fairway, not in sand traps.
- c) No gimmies for Captain's Choice rounds, inside the leather for individual round

Scoring:

First Round: Each person will keep their individual score. You will be scored according to your handicap. For example, if you have a 28 handicap (avg. score of 100), you will get 1 stroke on each hole (18 strokes) plus a stroke on each of the 10 hardest handicap holes to equal your 28 handicap. You will gain points by the following guidelines (your handicap with the above calculations will be considered):

Eagle = 3 points; Birdie = 2 points; Par = 1 point; Bogey or higher = no points

Second Round: The second round will be a captain's choice tournament. Each player will hit their own ball and the team will decide which one is the best to play for the next shot. Everyone will then drop a ball and hit from that spot. Do this all the way into the cup! The key to making this work is that everyone is placed on teams with people that have similar handicaps. Your goal is to have the team choose your ball to hit from on each shot. Each time your ball is chosen to be played, you will get a point. Someone should be responsible for keeping point totals for your group. On the last putt, everyone in the group should get the opportunity to putt. Each player that makes the putt can count the point. The groups will be given extra points based on what order they come in: First group, 8 points, second 6 points, third 4 points, fourth 2 points, fifth 0 points to be added to their individual point totals.

Third Round: This will be played the same as the first round. Each person will keep

their individual score. You will be scored according to your handicap. For example, if you have a 28 handicap (avg. score of 100), you will get 1 stroke on each hole (18 strokes) plus a stroke on each of the 10 hardest handicap holes to equal your 28 handicap. You will gain points by the following guidelines (your handicap with the above calculations will be considered):

Eagle = 3 points; Birdie = 2 points; Par = 1 point; Bogey or higher = no points

The player with the least amount of points at the end of all three rounds will be our last place finisher and our champion! He will take home Myrtle! The following table is the scoring chart for the tournament. I took your scores from the past few years and updated them a little. For those of you new to the tournament, I took your word for your handicap so make sure it is correct.
